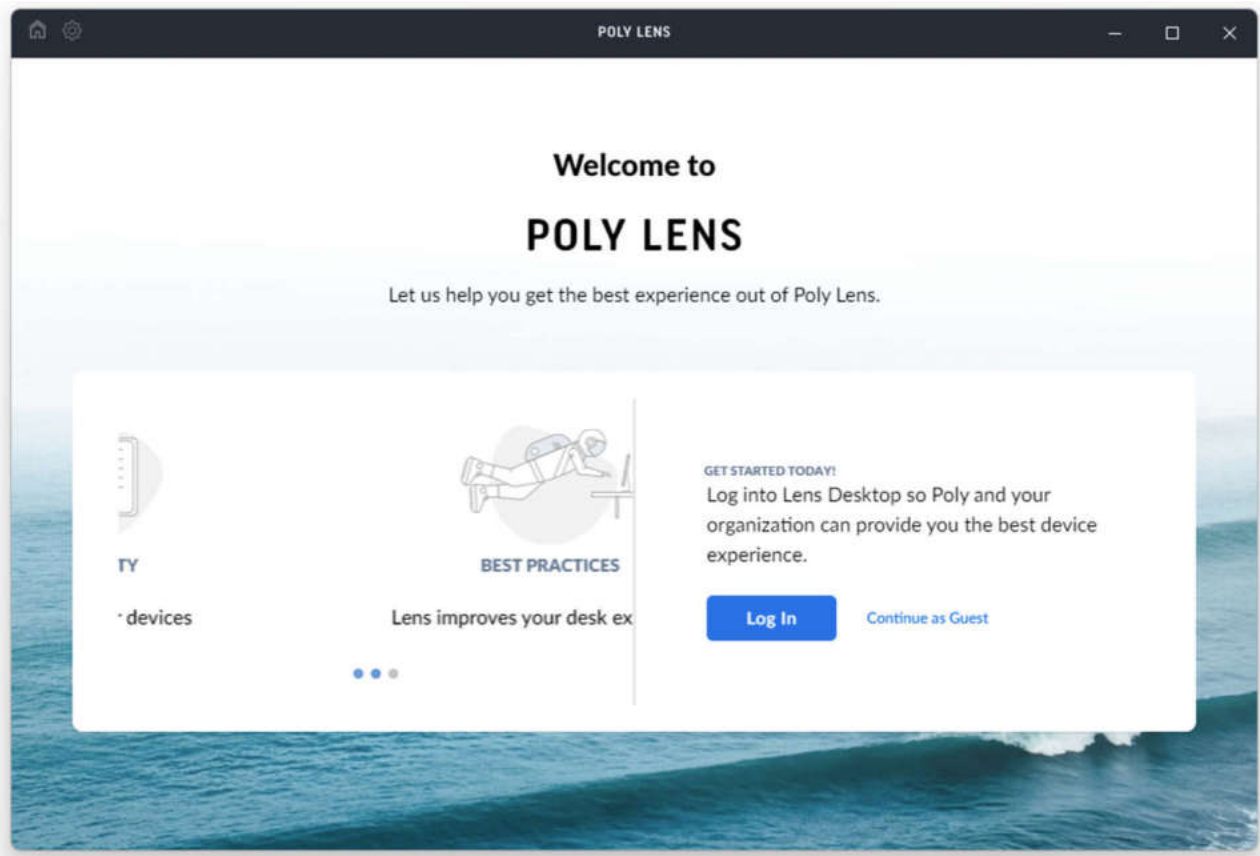

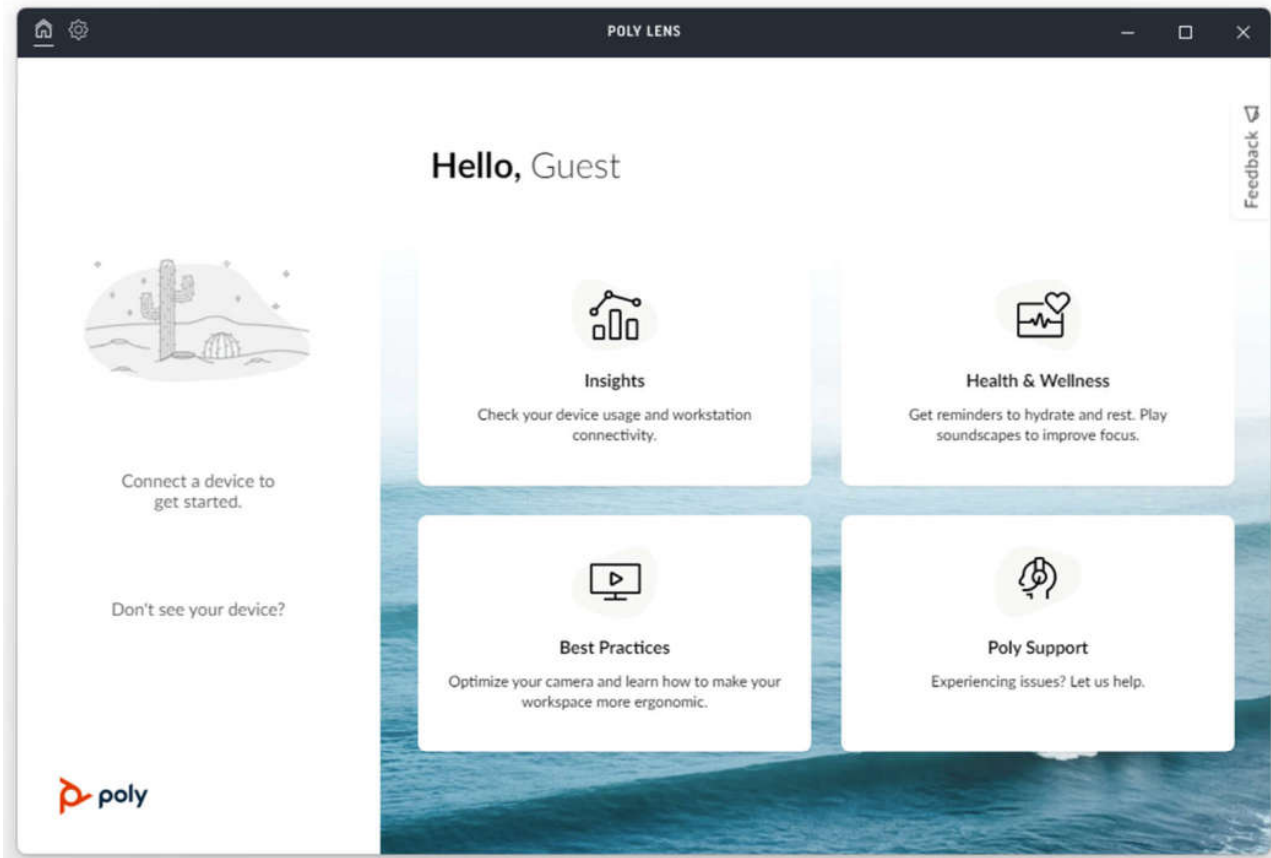

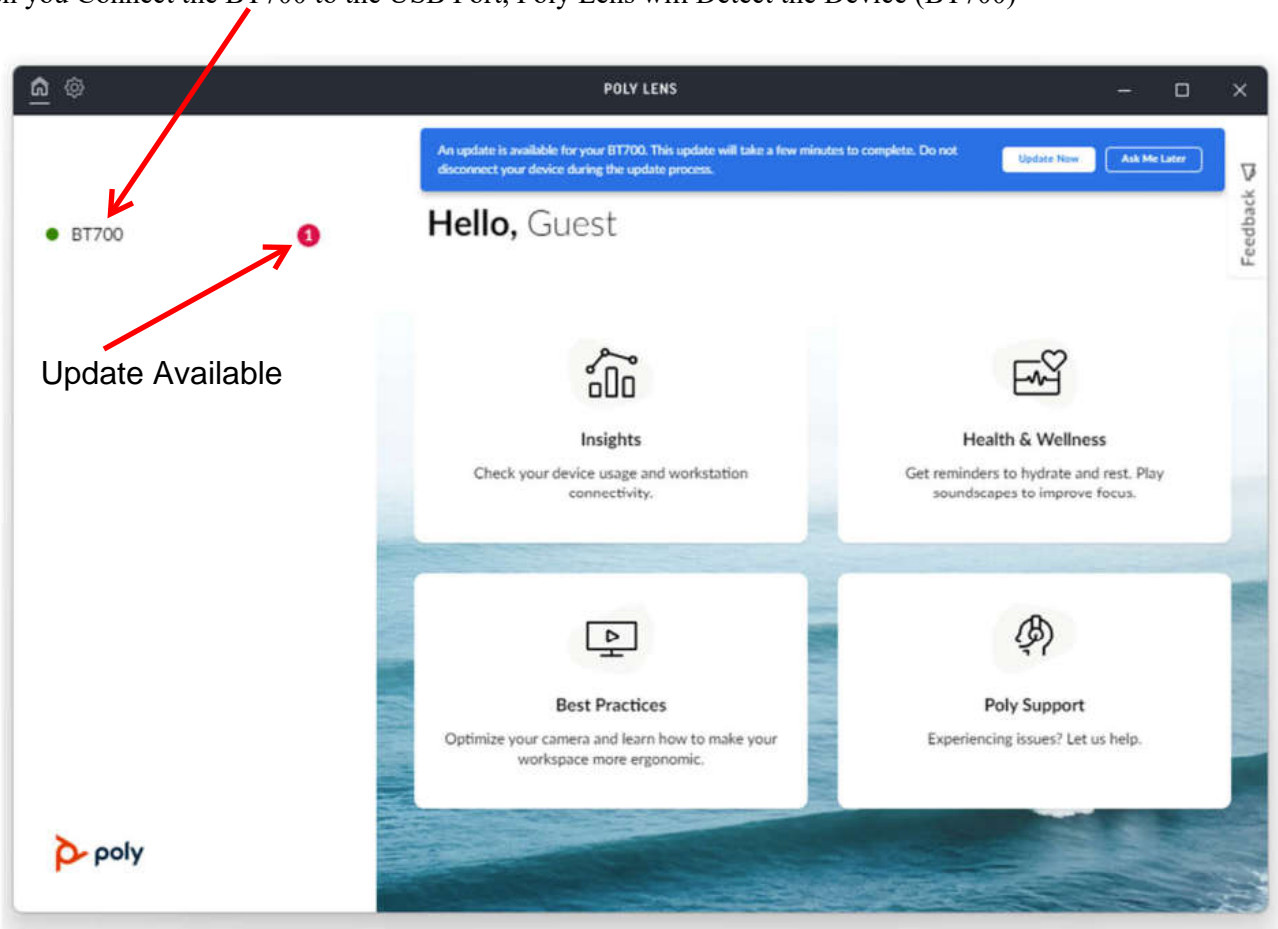
After Downloading and Launching the Application you will see the following Screen



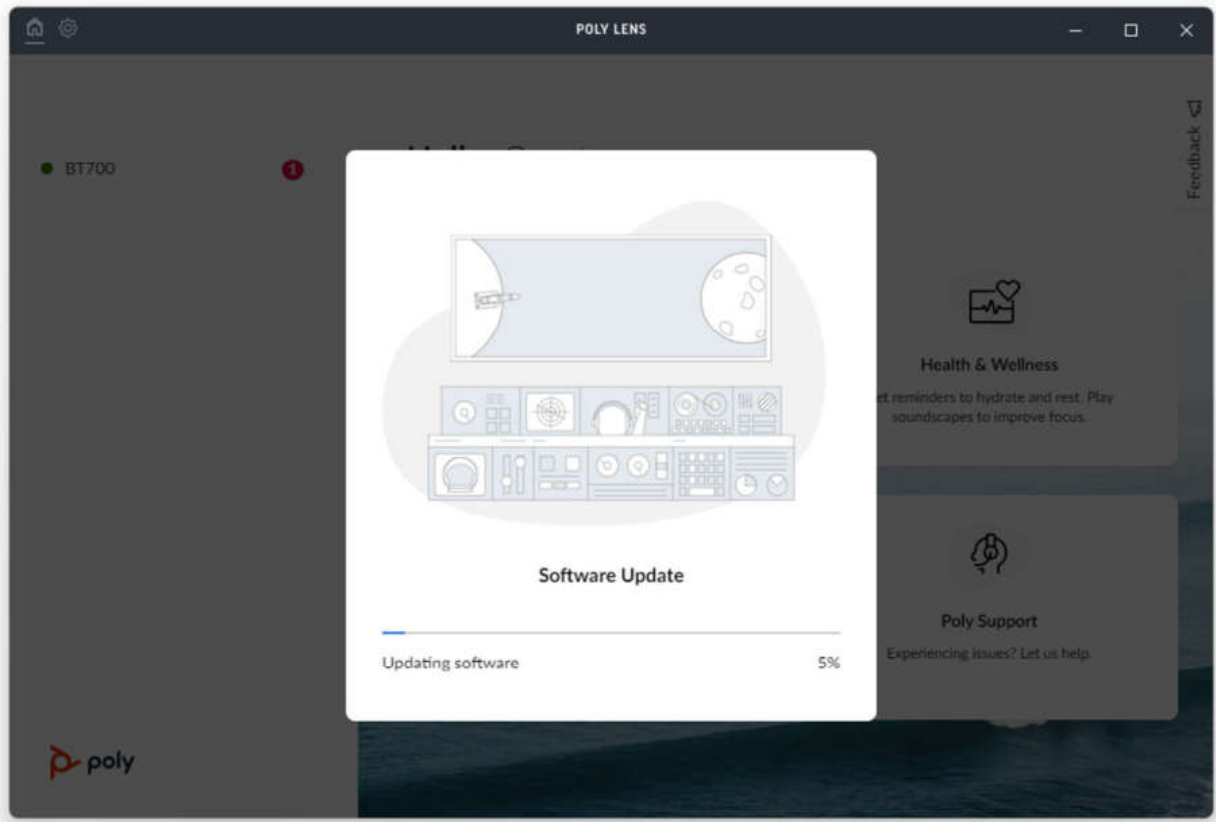
Click on "Continue as Guest", you will see the following Screen below



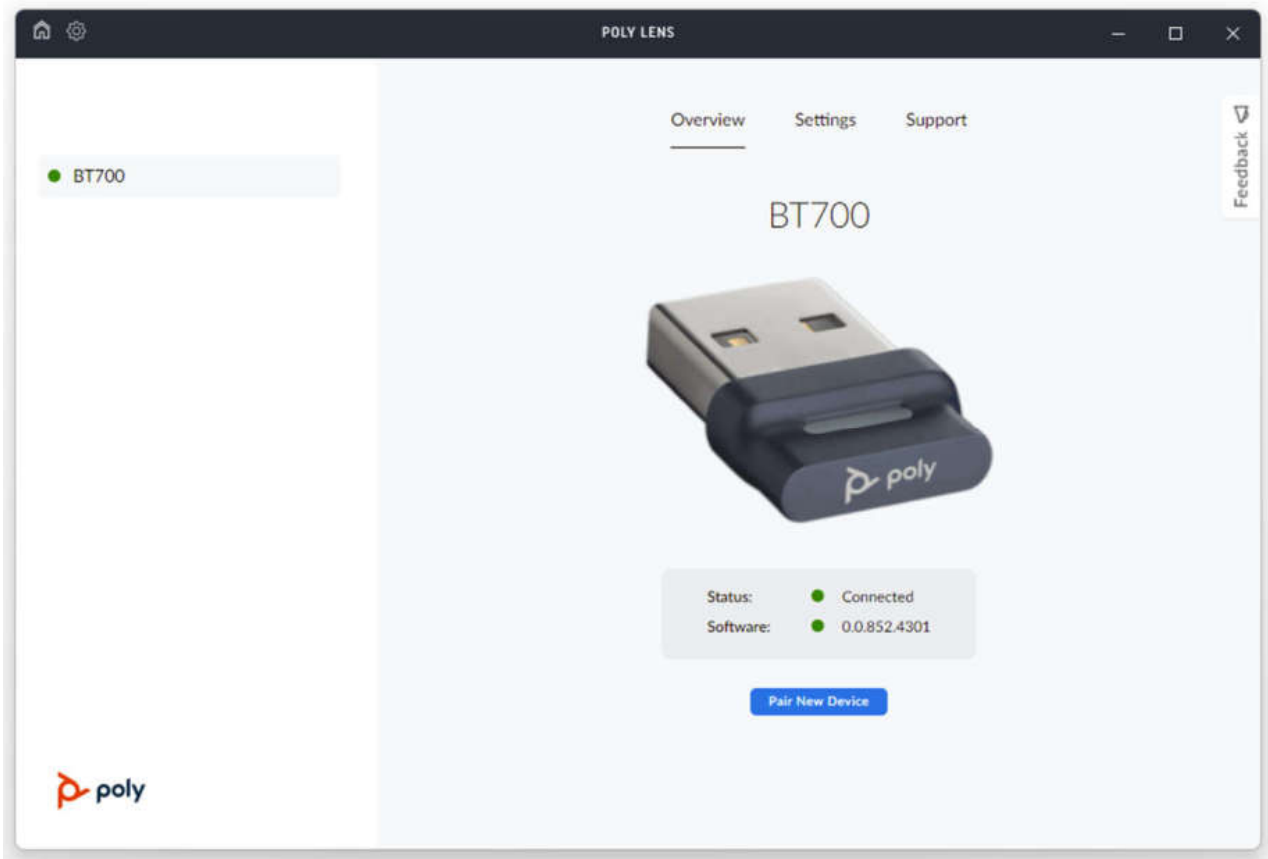
When you Connect the BT700 to the USB Port, Poly Lens will Detect the Device (BT700)



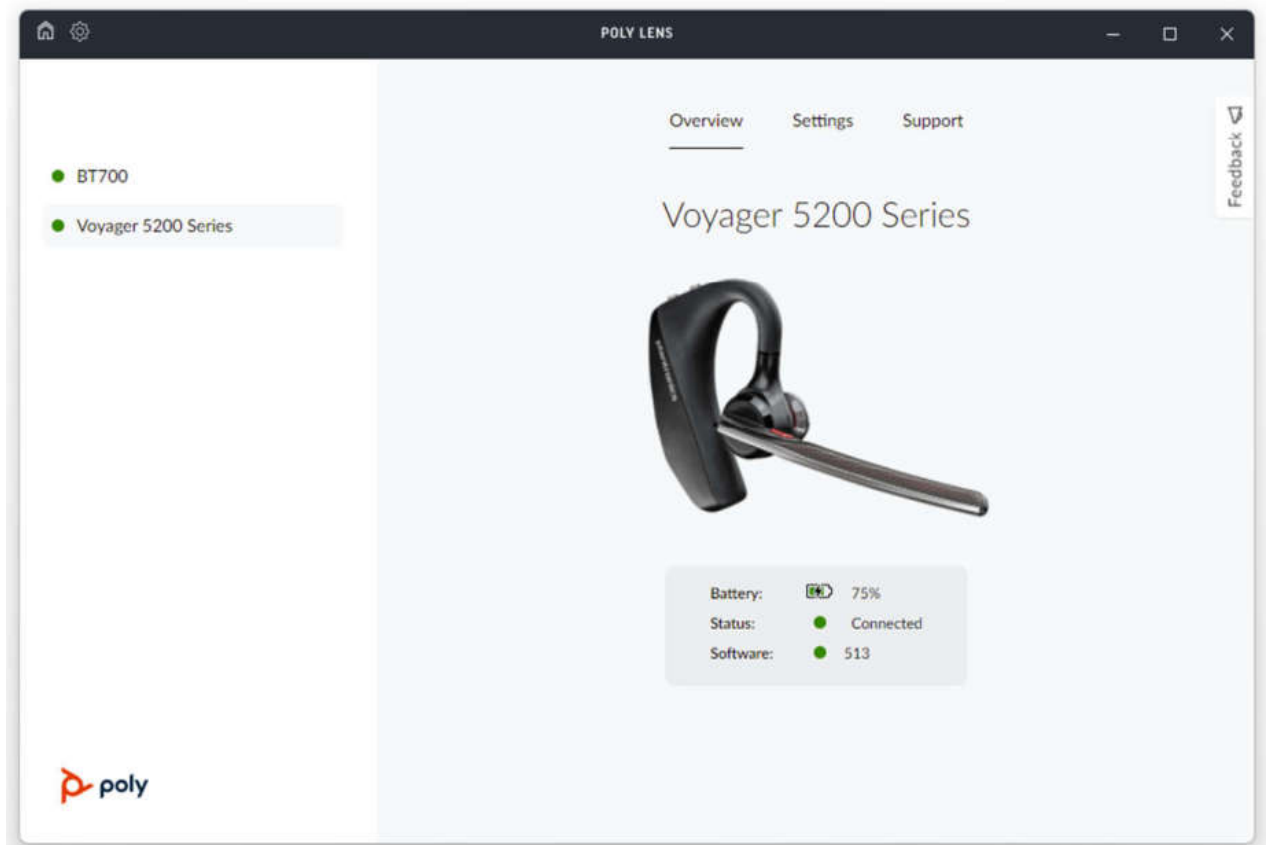
Once Device (BT700) is Detected it will be Displayed.

After Updating you will see the Device (BT700)

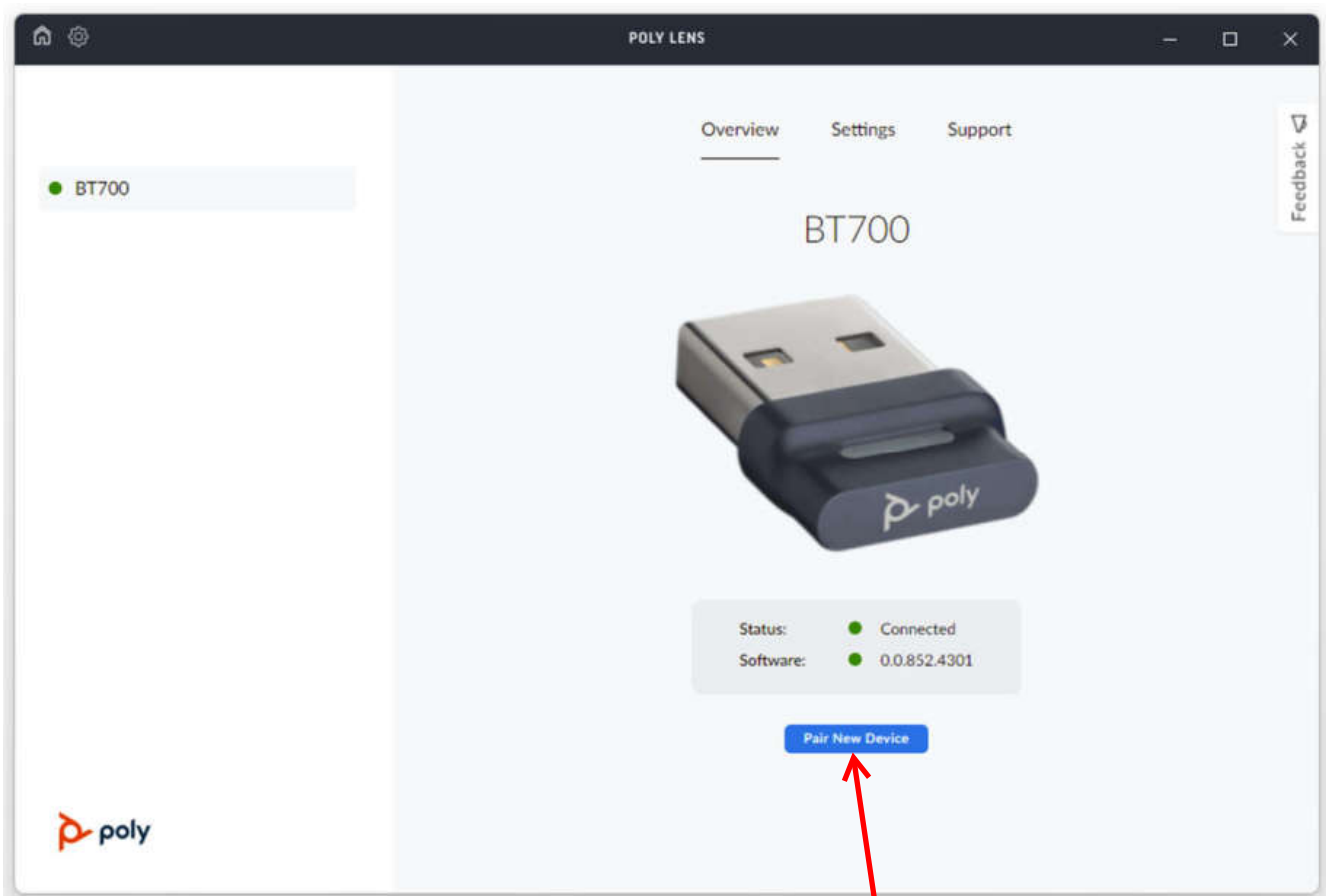
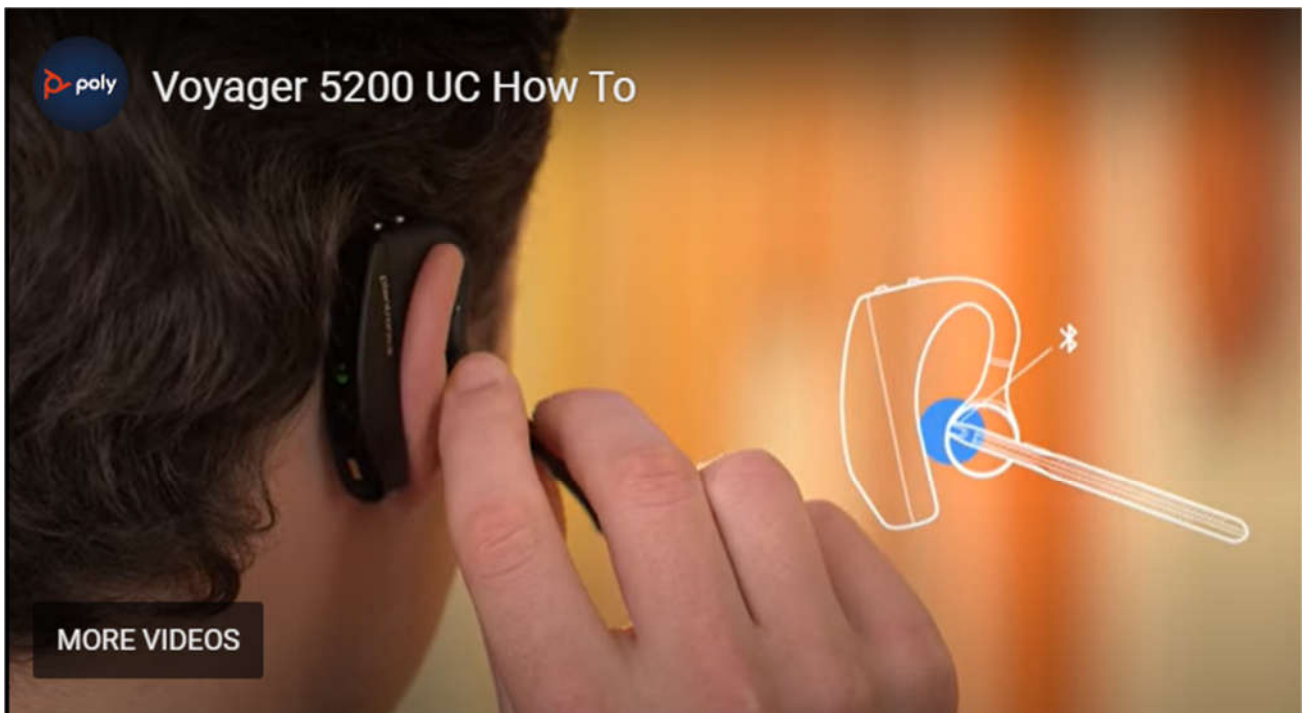


You can Connect the Voyager 5200 to PC via a USB Cable to the Headset.



Once the Voyager 5200 is Detected we can Confirm that both BT700 and Voyager 5200 are Working.

To Pair the Headset to the BT700 you will need to Turn on the Headset and Press the Headset Button at the End of the Microphone Boom as shown below until you Hear Pairing.



To set the BT700 into Pairing Mode you will need to Go to Poly Lens and Click “Pair New Device” the BT700 Adapter will Start to Flash Blue-Red, once Pairing is Completed the Adapter will Turn Solid Blue when Connected.
